# MATHEMATICS DAY QUIZ PROGRAM

As a tribute to Mathematical Genius **“SHRI SRINIVASA RAMANUJAN”** every year on his birthday 22 December is celebrated as National Mathematics Day. As a part of this, with the objective of fostering analytical thinking, logical reasoning and a deeper appreciation of mathematics among students of our department. A **Mathematics Quiz** was organized on 29 December 2025 by the Quiz Masters; research scholars of Department of Studies in Mathematics, Manasagangotri. The program was conducted under the esteemed guidance and encouragement of the **Chairperson, Dr. Veena Mathad, and Senior Professor Dr. K. R. Vasuki**, Department of Studies in Mathematics, University of Mysore, Manasagangotri, Mysuru.

In the first round, a preliminary screening test was conducted to shortlist students based on merit. A total of 20 students were shortlisted, of whom 13 were second year students and the remaining 7 were first year students. These shortlisted participants were allotted into 5 teams of four each through a chit system. The teams were designated as **Alpha, Beta, Gamma, Delta and Lambda**.

The quiz comprised several rounds designed to assess diverse mathematical knowledge. The second round was a **Picture Round**, followed by the third round, a **Clue Round**. The fourth round featured a **Crossword Round**, while the fifth round was a **Math Rebus Round**. The sixth and final round tested participants knowledge by requiring them to identify the authors of mathematics textbooks. The student audience actively responded to the questions passed on from other teams, reflecting their enthusiasm, alertness, and sound understanding of mathematical concepts.

Upon the successful completion of all rounds, the Lambda team secured the first position, with the Delta team emerging as the runners up, the Beta team achieved the third position, while the fourth position was shared jointly by the remaining teams.

The event was conducted successfully and witnessed active participation from students, thereby contributing to an intellectually stimulating and competitive academic environment.
