When the University was established in 1916, Commerce was offered at the undergraduate level for a couple of years and withdrawn subsequently because other professional courses such as Engineering were introduced.

Ramnarayan Chellaram College of Bangalore was known for Commerce Education in the 1940s. Only in the 1950s D.Banumaiah's College of Commerce was established. Commerce education got phillip in 1960s . With the starting of several other Commerce Colleges ,and introduction of commerce discipline in the Science and Arts Colleges as well in the 70s helped its spread and popularity..
