GENESIS:

The Department of Studies in Education was established in 1956 and it is one of the oldest departments of education in India, which was initially started at the University Teachers College and later got shifted to the Manasagangotri campus in 1960 as an independent department. Master of Education (M.Ed. - part-time) and Master of Arts (M.A.) in Education programmes were offered till 1976. One year Master of Education (M.Ed.) programme was offered from 1976 to 2014. The Doctoral Degree in Education programme has been offered from early 1970s. A Two-year Master of Education (M.Ed.) professional programme was introduced in 2015 as per NCTE Regulations 2014. The department has successfully accomplished 63 batches of M.Ed. About 250 candidates have been awarded Ph.D. in Education till date. The Alumni Association was established in 1970s is an added feather in the cap of the department and has about 3000 members across the country and abroad.
