Introduction

Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), launched in 2013 and aims at providing strategic funding to eligible higher educational institutions in the state.

The central funding in the ratio of 60:40 would be norm based and outcome dependent.

The funding is from the central ministry through the state governments to the State Higher Education Councils before reaching the identified institutions.

The funding to states would be made on the basis of critical appraisal of State Higher Education Plans, which would describe each state's strategy to address issues of equity, access and excellence in higher education.

RUSA is the central government's plan to develop every state university.
