AMENDMENT OF PH.D REGULATIONS-2017

Existing Amendment

Additional Amendment

3.1 The Doctoral Committee, constituted by the university, shall consist of:

(d) Two Faculty Members/ Scientists of the faculty members/Scientists are those who are in the broad area of the research work proposed by the candidate and who have guided at least one Ph.D candidate

The Guide shall be the Chairperson of the Doctoral Committee. Wherever Guide is also the Chairperson of the Department/Chairperson of the Board of Studies, another Senior Faculty Member/ Scientist shall be included in theCommittee. In such Departments wherein the number of faculty is less than two, members of the Doctoral Committee shall be chosen from sister Departments. As the members of the Doctoral Committee may change due to superannuation, resignation of faculty or any other reason (s), these can be filled up by the University upon written request from the Guide, whose membership in the Committee is by name only.

4.1 (a) Professors or Scientists of equivalent cadre working on regular basis in Departments of Studies of the University/Recognized Research Centers of the University are recognized as Ph.D. Guides in their subjects concerned, by virtue of their positions. However, if they wish to supervise candidates in other disciplines/ interdisciplinary subjects, then they have to formally apply for such recognition as prescribed in 4.1(d).

3.1 The Doctoral Committee, constituted by the university, shall consist of:

(d) Two Faculty Members/ Scientists of the Department/Institution suggested by the guide. The Department/Recognized Research Institution of the University, as suggested by the guide. The faculty members/Scientists are those who are in the broad area of the research work proposed by the candidate and who have guided atleast one Ph.D candidate.

> The Guide shall be the Chairperson of the Doctoral Committee. Wherever Guide is also the Chairperson of the Department/Chairperson of the Board of Studies, another Senior Faculty Member/ Scientist shall be included in the Committee. In such Departments wherein the number of faculty is less than two, the members of the Doctoral Committeeshall be chosen from sister concerned Departments/ from departments of allied subjects. As the members of the Doctoral may change superannuation, resignation of faculty or any other reason (s), the doctoral committee Chairman/Guide shall invite the BoS Chairman, or his/her Nominee. for the Pre-Registration Committee. Pre-Thesis Colloquium, and Open Voice Viva examination for the candidate who are intended to do research work in the recognized research centres/constituent Colleges affiliated to University of Mysore.

> 4.1 (a) Professors or Scientists of equivalent cadre working on regular basis in Departments of Studies of theUniversity/Recognized Research Centers of the University are recognized as Ph.D. Guides in their concerned subjects, by virtue of their positions. The University shall constitute separate BOS for interdisciplinary subjects, under the chairmanship of Deans of concerned faculty(ies), depending upon the requirement. In such BOS, there shall be a maximum of five members. Such guides have to formally apply for recognition of Guideship as prescribed in 4.1(d).

- 4.1 (e) Faculty/Scientists who join the University after serving elsewhere with three years of regular teaching/ research experience in a relevant discipline, are also eligible to be considered for recognition as guide if they satisfy the other requirements as mentioned in (a), (b),(c) and (d).
- 4.1 (e) Faculty/Scientists who join the University after serving elsewhere with three years of regular teaching/ research experience in a relevant discipline, are also eligible to be considered for recognition as guide if they satisfy the other requirements as mentioned in (a), (b),(c) and (d).

Those who would like to become guides with a National level fellowship Awards, wherein they are allowed to guide candidates as per the guidelines of funding agencies, and the duration of the fellowship is for a short period, they may be do so as co-guides, by registering the candidates under a permanent and regular guide of the subject of the university, which is

essential as per UGC norms.

- 5.9 Candidates who have qualified JRF fellowships/ UGC/CSIR-NET/DBTlecturership through SLET Examinations/ JRF/ICMR-JRF/ICAR (KSET)/ GATE are exempted from Entrance test. Candidates, who have completed M. Phil course/who have joined M.Phil. course are also exempted from the entrance test provided the M.Phil /Equivalent course was through an entrance examination. However all such candidates have to undergo an interview before the probable guide(s) and obtain the consent/acceptance letter from the guide, if vacancies are available.
- 5.9 Candidates who have qualified JRF fellowships/ UGC/CSIR-NET/DBTthrough lecturership JRF/ICMR-JRF/ICAR Examinations/ SLET (KSET)/ GATE are exempted from Entrance test. Candidates. who have completed their M. Phil course/who have joined for M.Phil. course are also exempted from the entrance test for Ph.D. provided that the M.Phil admission was through an entrance examination. However all such candidates have to obtain the consent/acceptance letter from the guide, if vacancies are available.
- 6.1 All provisionally registered candidates shall undergo COURSE-WORK of one semester duration of 20 weeks
- inclusive course-end assessment. The University shall notify the time table and details of the course work including the schedule.
- 6.1 All provisionally registered candidates shall undergo COURSE-WORK of one semester duration of 20 weekswhich includes the internal assessment. The coursework is to be conducted within the /constituent research centres recognised colleges/institutions, if there are minimum 05 candidates enrolled for doctoral degree, in each subject. The University shall notify the time table and details of the course work including the schedule. The chairperson of the departments shall co-ordinate the work related from admission to examination processes. In case of dire necessity of shifting the candidates to some other nearby centres, the work load of teaching the coursework should also be shared by those guides.

Finally the committee recommends for the ambiguities to be attended in Ph.D regulation. The Chairman thanked the members for their participation and suggestions.
