I University Level Camps :

N.D.R.K. First Grade College, Hasaan had organized District Level Camp from 05.10.2015 to 11.10.2015 at Heragu Village, Dudda Hobli, Hassan Taluk, Hassan District. Totally 160 (83 male and 77 female) NSS volunteers and NSS Officers participated in the Camp. During the camp cleaning the premises school and temples, cleaning of roads, construction of roads, health checkup programme, cleansiness awareness programme were conducted and many resource persons were invited to the camp for the benefit of volunteers and villagers of the camp.

Govt. First Grade College, Pandavapura had organized District Level Camp from 15.10.2015 to 21.10.2015 at Manikyanahalli Village, Melkote Hobli, Pandavapura Taluk, Mandya District. Totally 175 (92 male and 83 female) NSS volunteers and NSS Officers participated in the Camp. During the camp shramadan were conducted by cleaning the road, cleaning of drainage, construction of toilet pits, health checkup programme, veterinary checkup programme, cleansiness, health awareness programme and resource persons were invited to the camp for the benefit of volunteers and villagers of the camp.

Sri Mahadeshwara First Grade College, Kollegal had organized District Level Camp from 20.10.2015 to 26.10.2015 at Moraji Desai Residential School, Thimmarajapura, Kollegal Taluk, Chamarajanagar District. Totally 107 (77 male and 30 female) NSS volunteers and NSS Officers participated in the Camp. During the camp shramadan were conducted by repairing the old roads, cleaning the village, planting of saplings, cleaning school, milk dairy and temple premises, cleaning of old pond Hosabavi Pond and Hunasekatte Pond programme were conducted. Veterinary checkup programme, special lectures programme, health checkup cup, legal awareness, rain water harvesting, awareness of diseases, cultural programme, yoga, sports and personality development and jatha programme were conducted during the camp.

Maharaja's College, Mysore had organized District Level Camp from 29.10.2015 to 04.11.2015 at Karimuddanahalli Village, Bilikere Hobli, Hunsur Taluk, Mysore District. Totally 158 (104 male and 54 female) NSS volunteers and NSS Officers participated in the Camp. During the camp, shramadan were conducted by cleaning the village, health checkup programme, protecting the environment and water source management, eradication of parthenium, Aids awareness, programme on women, empowerment, literacy programmes, eradication of plastics, programme awareness against eradication of drug abuse, legal awareness programme were conducted and many resource persons were invited to the camp.

During the camps 5 important components has been conducted. 1. Morning Flag hoisting 2.Shramadan, 3. Special speech 4.Different competitions and 5. Cultural programme.

Everyday during shramadan planting of saplings and digging of pits were done with the help of villagers. Construction of new roads and drainage, cleaning of roads of villages, construction of toilet pits, cleaning of ponds and wells.

Under the special lecture daily renowned resource persons were invited for delivering the speech on personality development, health awareness to the villages and volunteers, students role in protecting environment and environment development, agriculture and programme on benefits from the government in respect of agriculture.

Each day of the camp cultural competitions were held like Pick and speak, quiz, patriotic song, folk song, mono acting etc., were held.

Along with the above programme, in collaboration with the health department of the village, blood grouping, blood donation, eye and dental checkup camp were conducted and issued lakhs of worth of medicines and spectacles were issued at free of cost. Veterinary checkup were also done with the help of Veterinary department.

II College Level Camp :

Colleges of University of Mysore, Mysore who is having NSS 109 Special Camp were conducted in rural areas of Mysore, Chamarajanagar, Mandya and Hassan. Totally 7194 NSS volunteers and Programme Officers participated in the camps.

III Inter Collegiate Camp :

The 40th Inter Collegiate Camp was conducted by NSS wing of University of Mysore, Mysore from 08.07.2015 to 14.07.2015 at Sir.M.Visveswaraiah P.G.Centre, Tubinakere, Mandya. More than 207 NSS volunteers and NSS Programme Officers participated in the Camp. During the camp, cultural folk songs, farce, debate, mono acting competitions were held. Daily yoga training were held. On account of shramadan bushes were cleaned in the premises of the centre. Digging of 250 nos. of pits for the plantation during rainy season were done. Each day resource persons were invited and lecture programme were conducted. On first day Prof.B.K.Shivanna spoke on the history of 'National Service Scheme and its benefits on other days, Dr.H.S.Suresh, Retd. Asst.
