CBCS –CAGP

The first batch under CBCS-CAGP is coming out from the University .In this backdrop the following points may kindly be observed.

1. By this time every department could have experienced that at any point of time , there shall be only type of semester, namely either ODD semester or EVEN semester. This implies that in principle a student can register for courses notified either under I or III Semester during ODD semester or under II or IV semester during EVEN semester, subject to the fact that the time table need to be suitably framed. It is natural that a student has to register for a specific course ,with certain pre-requisite being satisfied.
2. Sufficient choice should be available for a student to choose a soft core course/an open elective course. He should also get reasonable amount of time to make a decision regarding this.
3. Hence forth, office of the Registrar (Eval) shall take all measures to declare the semester-end results and conduct the make-up examination well within the stipulated schedule, and therefore it is necessary that all departments co-operate in communicating $C_1 + C_2$ scores much before the start of semester - end examinations.
4. After the completion of IV semester, some (very few) students may still require one or two more semesters (up to a max of 8 semesters in all) to complete 76 credits. Such students shall register in the spillover semesters for certain courses, attend classes, earn $C_1 + C_2$ and take up C_3 component also. Such students have to remit the re-registration fee as shall be indicated by the University from time to time.
