You are already aware that the University is conducting common entrance test for all P.G. admissions from 2013-14. This test is compulsory for all aspirants from this University and from other Universities. Filing the application form for entrance test and getting a score in entrance test is compulsory for admission to P.G. Courses in the University departments, University P.G.Centres, University Constituent Colleges and University Affiliated Colleges. However, Autonomous Colleges are exempted from this requirement.

In this regard the Chairpersons of BoS (PG/Composite) are required to consult local members of BoS and arrange to send the following information to the Registrar with a copy to the Registrar (Evaluation) latest by May 23, 2013 positively.

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1. The syllabus for the Entrance Test will be the undergraduate syllabus of the University of Mysore for the duration of Academic year between 2010-2013. This syllabus should be regrouped into 10 equal Units. The entrance test will be for one hour duration and will be for 50 marks. 50 multiple Choice questions. Students answer the test in OMR sheets. From each unit 5 question will be set in the Entrance Test.
2. The BoS shall clearly mention the eligibility criteria for writing the entrance test and also eligibility criteria for getting admitted to the course. These details are absolutely necessary to avoid legal complications later.
3. In cases where a department offers more than one course, syllabus has to be framed separately for each course. No common exam will be held. Each course will have its own entrance exam.
4. The BoS shall recommend a list of 5 external examiners to get the question papers set for entrance test. The experts can also be from outside Karnataka.
5. The BoS should also ensure that the syllabus for entrance test is uploaded in the University Webpage. Kindly send the details pertaining to the above in hard copy and soft copy latest by May 23, 2013.
