

ADMISSION TO 5-YEAR INTEGRATED M.Sc. COURSE IN MOLECULAR BIOLOGY

Instructions - Entrance Examination

Entrance examination is a mandatory requirement for admission to 5-Year Integrated M.Sc. in Molecular Biology offered by Yuvaraja's College, University of Mysore. Foreign nationals with foreign degree are exempted from the entrance examination.

Entrance Examination will be conducted on 29th June 2013 at Yuvaraja's College between 12.00 pm – 1.00 pm.

Candidates appearing for the entrance examination are requested to note down the following points:

1. Admission ticket for entrance examination will be issued between 10.30 – 11.30 am on the date of examination
2. Candidates must bring two recent passport size photographs for issuing of admission ticket.
3. Entrance examination fee has to be paid through Demand Draft of Rs. 400/- with the application form before 22nd June 2013. **Candidate who fails to submit the duly filled application with demand draft on or before 22nd June 2013 are not eligible to take Entrance Examination.**
4. The Entrance examination is based on the syllabus comprising of 10 units approved by the Board of Studies in Molecular Biology is uploaded on the websites (<http://www.yuvarajacollege.org> or <http://www.ycmmb.webs.com> or <http://www.uni-mysore.ac.in>).
5. The Entrance Examination is of 1 hr duration with 50 multiple choice questions of 1 mark each for a maximum of 50 marks. To be answered in **OMR sheets**.

6. Rank list of candidates for admission will be prepared taking Entrance examination marks and 50% weightage of qualifying examination marks in science stream.
7. The results of the Entrance examination will be announced in the Department Notice board and also in the websites.
8. Candidates not appearing for Entrance examination are not eligible for admission to molecular biology programme.
9. The candidate list – selection list/waiting list will also be announced on the department notice board and also in the web site.
10. Separate intimation will not be sent to the candidates.
