

ANNOUNCEMENT

The KSET center, Pareeksha Bhavan, University of Mysore will be holding the Test for determining the eligibility for Lectureship (Assistant Professorship) in the year 2013. Candidates who qualify in K-SET will be eligible to apply for the post of Lectureship / Assistant Professorship in any universities / colleges / Institutions of Higher Education (Government/ Aided/ Private) in **Karnataka State only**.

The UGC has given accreditation to conduct K-SET examination for the following **32 subjects**.

Notification will be issued inviting On-line applications for the K-SET in the month of **July 2013** and the examination will be conducted in the month of **November /December 2013**. Application forms will be made available in the University website site [http:// uni-mysore.ac.in](http://uni-mysore.ac.in). Hard copy of the application form has to be submitted to the respective NODAL officers in different University centers along with their PG marks card valid CASTE certificates (**Group-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB, SC/ST, VH/PH**).

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY :

Candidates who have secured at least 55% of aggregate marks (without rounding off) in Master's Degree OR equivalent examination from universities/institutions recognized by UGC, New Delhi are eligible for this Test. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste

(SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)//Physically Handicapped (PH)/Visually Handicapped (VH) category and who have secured at least 50% of aggregate marks (without rounding off) in Master's degree or equivalent examination are eligible for K-SET.

Candidates who have appeared OR will be appearing at the qualifying Master's Degree examination (Final year) and whose result is still awaited can also appear for the K-SET.

Candidates are advised to appear in the subject of their post-graduation only. However, in Science subjects candidates may appear in a related subject which will be announced in the Notification of K-SET.

AGE LIMIT:

There is no upper age limit for applying for Lectureship.

EXAMINATION FEE:

Details of Examination fee and mode of payment etc., will be announced in the website shortly.

SYLLABUS AND EXAMINATION PAPERS:

The syllabus for different subjects for K-SET examination will be the same as that of UGC-NET and UGC-CSIR examination. Syllabus for KSET will be made available in the University website during Notification.

The K-SET will consist of three papers, **Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III**. All the three papers will consist of **only objective type, multiple choice questions**.

Paper-I shall be of general nature with Sixty (60) multiple choice questions of two marks each out of which the candidate would be required to **answer any fifty (50)**.

Paper-II shall consist of questions based on the subject selected by the candidate and Each paper will consist of **50 compulsory objective type questions** of two marks each.

The candidate will have to mark the responses for questions of Paper-I and Paper-II on the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet provided along with the Test Booklet.

Paper-III shall consist of questions based on the subject selected by the candidate and Each paper will consist of **75 compulsory objective type questions** of two marks each.

Criteria for declaration of K-SET results will be announced in the website shortly.
