- 1. Introduction to Criminology: Definitions and fundamental concepts of Criminology and crime; schools of Criminology; Victimology
- Introduction to Correctional Administration: meaning, theories and concept of punishments; Prisons; Community based Corrections.
- Forensic Science: Principles of Forensic Science; organization, functions and role of Forensic Science Laboratories, Fingerprints-meaning, pioneers and development of chance prints.
- 4. Forensic Medicine: nature and application of forensic Medicine; wounds, death and fundamentals of Toxicology.
- 5. Police: Administration and Organization; role in crime prevention; role in Investigation and Detection of crime.

SCHEME FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

- The examination is comprised of three parts i.e., Part A, B, and C. Part A and B are Objective type Questions.
- Part A will have General Knowledge Questions and Part B will have Subject Centered Questions. Each of these questions will carry ONE mark for the right answer.
- Part C will be of the Descriptive type questions and will be subject centric, based on the Syllabus given above. Each question carries TEN marks.
- The duration of the test shall be **2 Hrs** and shall carry **100 marks**.
