

Postgraduate Entrance Examination (PGEE): 2013-14

University of Mysore established in the year 1916, is an Institute of Excellence, accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade. As part of the ongoing quality improvement programs for imparting quality education, the university has introduced the entrance examination for admission to all PG programmes offered by the university in its campus, other PG centers and affiliated colleges from 2013-14.

**Entrance examination is a mandatory requirement for admission to all PG programmes offered by the University at Manasagangotri, PG Centers at Mandya, Hassan and Chamarajanagar and other Affiliated colleges except autonomous colleges.
Foreign nationals with foreign degree are exempted from the entrance examination.**

Entrance Examination (EE)

Entrance Examination is proposed to be held during last week of JULY 2013

Eligibility to appear for Entrance Examination

Candidates with bachelor's degree and those candidates appearing for the final semester examinations of bachelor's degree in the current academic year are also eligible.

Application for Entrance Examination (EE)

A separate notification inviting application for EE will be issued shortly.

Applications for the EE will be hosted on the university website: [**uni-mysore.ac.in**](http://uni-mysore.ac.in)

Candidates have to **apply separately for EE to each programme** to which they intend to seek admission.

(No common applications for different programmes of study/centers are entertained).

Candidates not appearing for EE are not eligible for admission to PG programmes.

Syllabus for EE

The EE is based on the syllabus comprising of 10 units prescribed by the respective Boards of Studies, will be hosted on the university website.

Procedure and duration of EE

Equal weightage will be given to all the units during question paper setting.

The unitized EE syllabus for all the PG programmes will be hosted on the university website.

The EE is of one hour duration for 50 marks, based on 50 objective type questions, to be answered in OMR sheets.

The key answers of the EE question paper will be hosted on the university website after all the EE.

Candidates are provided three days time to file objections, if any, for the key answers. The decision of the subject experts/ committee in this regard is final.

The results of the EE will be hosted on the university website.

Duly filled in applications for the EE along with the prescribed fee in the form of DD shall be submitted to **The Coordinator, PGEEC, Crawford Hall, University of Mysore, Mysore-570 005** on or before the last date mentioned in the notification.

Application for Admission

A separate notification, inviting applications for admission to PG programmes will be issued.

Candidates desirous of seeking admission to PG programmes have to **apply separately** for every programme/s at Departments/Centres/Institutes at Manasagangothri, PG Centers at Mandya, Hassan, Chamarajanagar and other Affiliated colleges, enclosing the EE marks of the concerned subjects.

Rank list of candidates for admission to respective programmes will be prepared by the respective departments taking EE marks and 50% weightage of qualifying degree examination marks.

Principals/ Directors/ Heads of Institutions are requested to bring this to the notice of students seeking admission to PG programmes of University of Mysore.
