

How to Reach Mysore

Travelling to Mysore is easy. It is well connected by road and rail to all the major cities in India and it has also a small airport. Mysore is 139 Kms to the south west of Bangalore. The state highway that connects these two cities is very well maintained. Travelling from Bangalore to Mysore by road will take about 3 hrs. There are ordinary buses, semi-luxury buses and luxury buses operated by the government of Karnataka. Every half an hour there is a non-stop bus to Mysore from Bangalore bus station. The quickest and most easiest way to reach Mysore is via Bangalore. The nearest airport is Bengaluru.
