

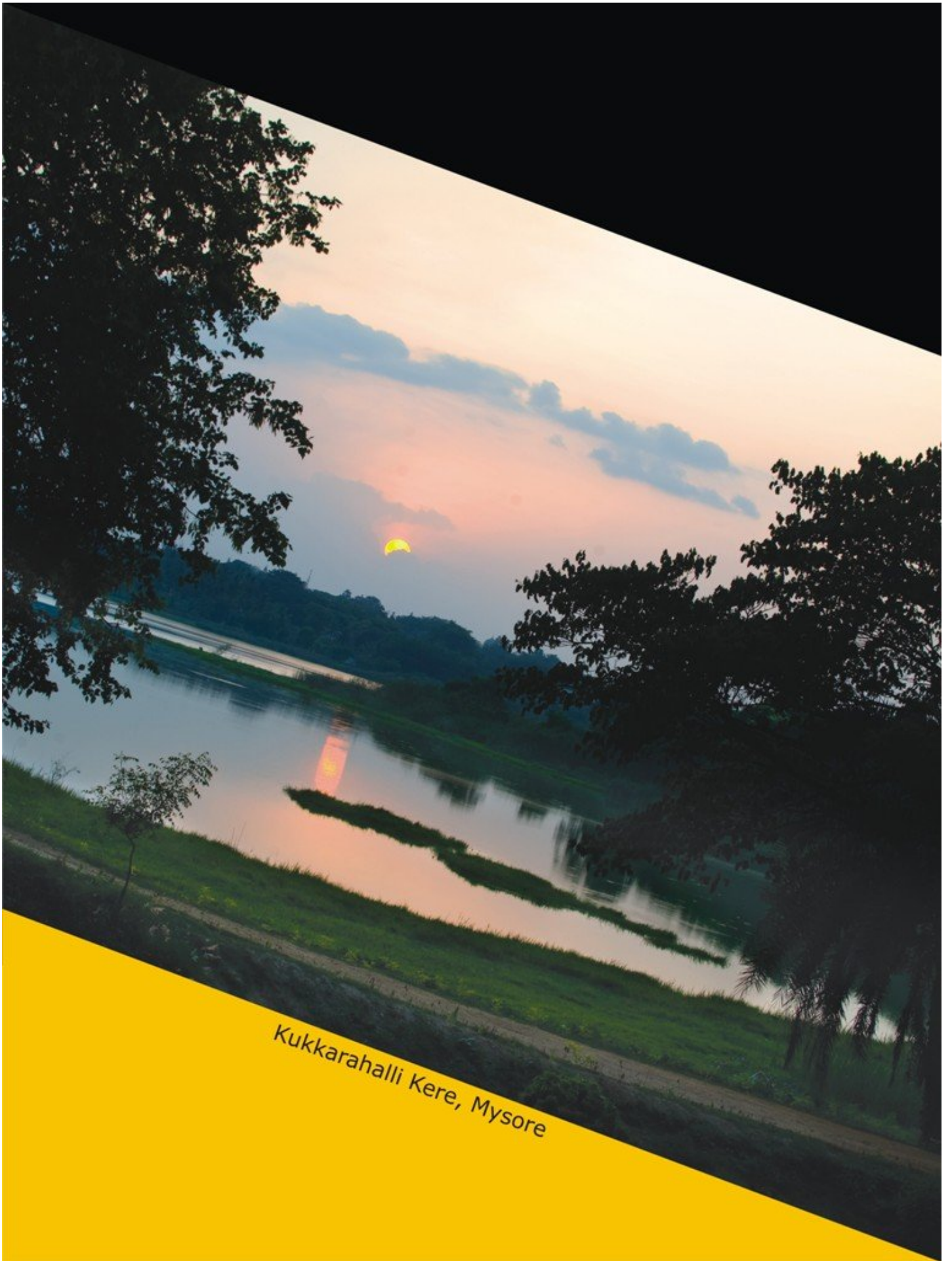

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ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY OF MYSORE

The first University in the state of Karnataka and the sixth oldest in India, the University of Mysore was established in the year 1916 by the then Maharaja of Mysore Sri Krishna Raja Wadiyar IV through munificent grants of land, buildings and financial resources. Home to a galaxy of stalwarts in the fields of education, administration, arts and sports, the University has earned an international identity for its academic programs and research activities. With a strong sense of commitment to social justice and equity the University provides access to people from all walks of life. The University of Mysore has always upheld the values of critical thinking, tolerance and open debate.

The University of Mysore has a string of laurels to its credit in the 93 years of its existence. It enjoys the unique distinction of having parented four universities in the state of Karnataka, these being Bangalore University in 1964, Mangalore University in 1980, Kuvempu University in 1987 and the Karnataka State Open University in 1996. With the four districts of Chamarajnagar, Hassan, Mandya and Mysore now under its jurisdiction, the University of Mysore has under its wing 4 constituent colleges and 183 affiliated colleges offering its undergraduate programs.

The main postgraduate campus of the University is located at Manasagangotri, which offers a panoramic view of the Kukkarahalli Lake and the Chamundi Hills, two of the city's most prominent landmarks. The campus houses 41 postgraduate departments offering 75 postgraduate degree and Diploma programs. The two postgraduate centers of the University are located at Hassan and Mandya, and offer postgraduate programs in select disciplines. Postgraduate programs are also now being offered in a few constituent and affiliated colleges.

The University of Mysore has a great research tradition. It has gained international repute for its research contributions in the fields of pure and applied sciences, language, literature and social sciences.

The University has also created a special provision for identifying and recognizing select institutions for conducting degree/diploma or research programs of the University of Mysore. The University also has arrangements with universities abroad for offering twinning programs.



The University emblem is adapted from the royal emblem of the erstwhile Mysore state. It depicts the bird Gandabherunda flanked on either side by the lion-elephant Sharabha (mythical creature believed to be stronger than lion and the elephant and upholder of righteousness) surrounded by a lion. The emblem also contains "satyamevoddaharamyham" meaning "I always uphold the truth".

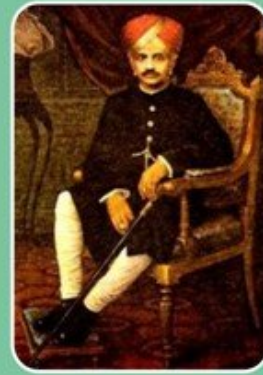
ABOUT THE CITY OF MYSORE

REACHING BEYOND OUR BORDERS

The University of Mysore has been making constant efforts to reach the masses and provide opportunities for them not only for knowledge acquisition, but also for enhancing the quality of their lives. It is as early as in 1933 that the University established Prasaranga as an independent division to take the message of education to the rural masses by organizing a series of lectures on a wide range of topics of contemporary relevance as well as on philosophy, religion, values etc. by eminent personalities in their respective fields. The Prasaranga published these lectures in the form of books and made them available to the public at large at affordable prices.

The University has recognized research institutions in different parts of the country for fostering research and academic collaborations. At present 50 such institutions are recognized by the University of Mysore.

The University of Mysore has entered into Memorandum of Understanding with institutions, industries and ministries in India and abroad to facilitate student and faculty exchange programmes and encourage collaborative research. Specially designed international academic programmes have also been initiated through these MoUs. The University has MoUs with Saginaw Valley State University, USA, Armstrong Atlantic State University, USA., Wuhan and Huanghuai Universities in China, University of North Texas, Denton, USA, University of Rovira I Virgili, Tarragona (Espana), Spain, Berlin School of Design, Germany, Ministry of Education, Government of Seychelles, Ragabhat University, Thailand, University of Science and Technology, Omdurman, Sudan, Ministry of Education, Republic of Maldives and the American institute of Indian Studies. Recently the University has extended its educational facilities to students in different parts of the country and students abroad through its outreach centers. The University has recognized institutions engaged in specialized studies to offer select courses.

- The University's Educational Multi Media Research Centre is the only one of its kind in the state of Karnataka.

OUR FACILITIES

ORIENTAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Established in the year 1891 by the then ruler of Mysore His Highness Sri Chamaraja Wodeyar, the Oriental Research Institute has a rare collection of 35,000 palm leaf bundles and paper manuscripts which is considered equivalent to 75,000-80,000 Sanskrit works. Kautilya's Arthashastra written in 4th Century B. C. was discovered edited and published by Vidwan Shamashastry of this Institute. The nine volume Encyclopedia in Sanskrit, Sritattvanidhi, compiled in 19th Century by the Mysore ruler Krishnaraja Wodeyar III is among the prized possessions of this Institute. As a feather to this heritage institute, a 'National Centre for History of Science' has been established with a grant of Rupees 1.5 crores from the University Grants Commission.



PRASARANGA (PUBLICATIONS DIVISION)

The Publications Division of the University established in 1933, with an intention to reach the unreached has been playing a pioneering role in the dissemination of knowledge through its publications and extension lecture series. Credited with 2000 titles of publications, our Prasaranga has produced a number of treatises such as English-Kannada Dictionary in 4 volumes and Kannada Grantha Suchi. It also publishes five subject journals-viz. Prabhudda Karnataka, Manavikaa Karnataka, Vignanaa Karnataka (all in Kannada), *myscience* and *mysociety*, apart from University News. The large collection of our publications is made available at subsidized rates to readers across the length and breadth of this country through exhibitions.



KUVEMPU INSTITUTE OF KANNADA STUDIES

The first of its kind to be established in the state of Karnataka for the study and promotion of Kannada language and literature, the Kuvempu Institute of Kannada Studies works through different sections such as the Editorial Division, Translation Division, Folklore Division and the Encyclopedia Division. The Institute is credited with the publication of all time classics as well as works of modern Kannada literature. The Institute has published more than 700 books on different subjects. The 14 volume Kannada Encyclopedia and the Epigraphia Karnataka published in 13 volumes by the Institute are its hallmarks. The Institute's library has a rare collection of works dating from 19th century and has been serving as a rich resource for scholars from across the globe.





FOLKLORE MUSEUM

The University Folklore Museum at the Jayalakshmi Vilas Mansion, Manasagangotri is considered one of the best of its kind in Asia. It has a precious collection of artifacts, handicrafts and indigenously made art forms from different parts of the state of Karnataka. A visit to this Museum is a veritable journey through a paradise of diversity.



AUDITORIA

Besides an open air amphitheater with a 3000 seater capacity, the University of Mysore has 4 more well equipped auditoria for organizing academic and cultural events. These are located at the Senate Bhavan complex, Maharaja's College, the University College of Fine Arts and the Bahadur Institute of Management Sciences.



MYSORE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

The University's main library located at the Manasagangotri campus has a resource collection of 6,50,000 documents, which include 75,000, bound volumes of journals. With 450 seating capacity the library is also home to precious archival and rare reference materials. Access to 5000 full text online journals is available through UGC-INFLIBNET and JSTOR.



CENTRE FOR INFORMATION SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (CIST)

The CIST offers a wide variety of postgraduate diploma and certificate programs in different fields of information technology. The primary objective of the Centre is to provide computer knowledge and training with hands-on experience for an alternate career path in the field of IT.



SPORTS

The University has excellent facilities for promoting and nurturing sports talent. The University's performance in regional and national sports events has been exemplary. Facilities for acquiring and developing sports skills are available in our indoor and outdoor stadiums. The University has a standard swimming pool, a gymnasium and a cinder track.

NATIONAL SINGLE CRYSTAL DIFFRACTOMETER FACILITY

The Department of Science and Technology (DST) in the year 1995 set up a national Single Crystal Diffractometer facility at the Department of Studies in Physics. The facility caters to the XRD data needs of crystallographers in the country. In the year 2000, DST funded the setting up of an Image Plate system. The facility is now well equipped to cater to the needs of the crystallographic community in India.



DROSOPHILA STOCK CENTRE

The Department of Biotechnology, Government of India recognized the potential of the Department of Zoology and awarded a grant for the establishment of a national facility for genetic stocks of Drosophila. The centre has received over 2000 genetic stocks of *D.melanogaster*. The facility caters to the needs of universities and research institutes in the country.

DANIDA/DBT/ICAR FACILITIES

The Department of Studies in Biotechnology has established Asian Seed Health Training and Research Centre with the support of Danish International Development Assistance (DANIDA) and Danish Seed Health Centre (DSHC) to strengthen regional cooperation among Asian countries in the area of seed health training and research. The Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India supports the M.Sc Biotechnology course in the Department under the HRD programme. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research has established field screening facility for Downy Mildew resistance in pearl millet.



EDUCATIONAL MULTIMEDIA RESEARCH CENTRE



The Audio Visual Research Centre established in the year 1996 has been rechristened as EMMRC. It is the only institution of its kind set up by the University Grants Commission in the state of Karnataka. The EMMRC broadcasts educational programmes on EDUSAT, a satellite launched exclusively for transmission of education related programmes by the Government of India.

GANDHI BHAVAN

One of the first Gandhi Bhavans to be established in India, way back in 1962, the University's Gandhi Bhavan has a long history of association with Gandhians, and institutions committed to promoting Gandhian philosophy. The Gandhi Bhavan has a rich collection of books dating back to the pre-independence period and is in the process of establishing a Gandhi Museum to preserve archival materials belonging to Gandhi era and other documents throwing light on Gandhiji's work and life.





OUR STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

There is a full fledged Directorate of Students Welfare that works for the all round development of students. There is also a well monitored security system in place. Besides there are also two health Centres and a Child Care Centre.

The University has 14 hostels providing accommodation on the campus for nearly 2,200 students.

There are as many as 404 gold medals and prizes, and a number of student fellowships instituted by philanthropists to promote competitive spirit among students.

A central internet facility for students, with 250 computers to be kept open for 16 hours a day is on the anvil. Besides, a Students' Proficiency Development, Training and Placement Cell that aims at identifying skills required for suitable jobs will soon be in place. The Centre will also maintain a data base on job opportunities and work for appropriate placements.



THE INTERNATIONAL HOSTEL

A recent addition to our quality initiatives for international students and faculty is the International Hostel with 90 spacious rooms, each with a balcony opening to the picturesque Kukkarahalli Lake. The independent rooms are equipped with space for study, internet connectivity, kitchenette facility, attached washrooms, and enclosed chests for safe keeping of belongings. The International Hostel also houses two computer labs and a spacious dining hall cum kitchen complex.

Reasonably priced accommodation is available in many residential areas in and around the university campus.





UNIVERSITY OF MYSORE-A GLOBAL EDUCATIONAL HUB

The University of Mysore is emerging as a global educational hub in recent times and its international student inflow is on the rise year after year. Home to the fourth largest number of international students in India, the University's academic image and an ambience that is perfect to the reckoning for the pursuit of knowledge have made it a globally sought after education destination. The University of Mysore has 1500 international students from as many as 50 countries.

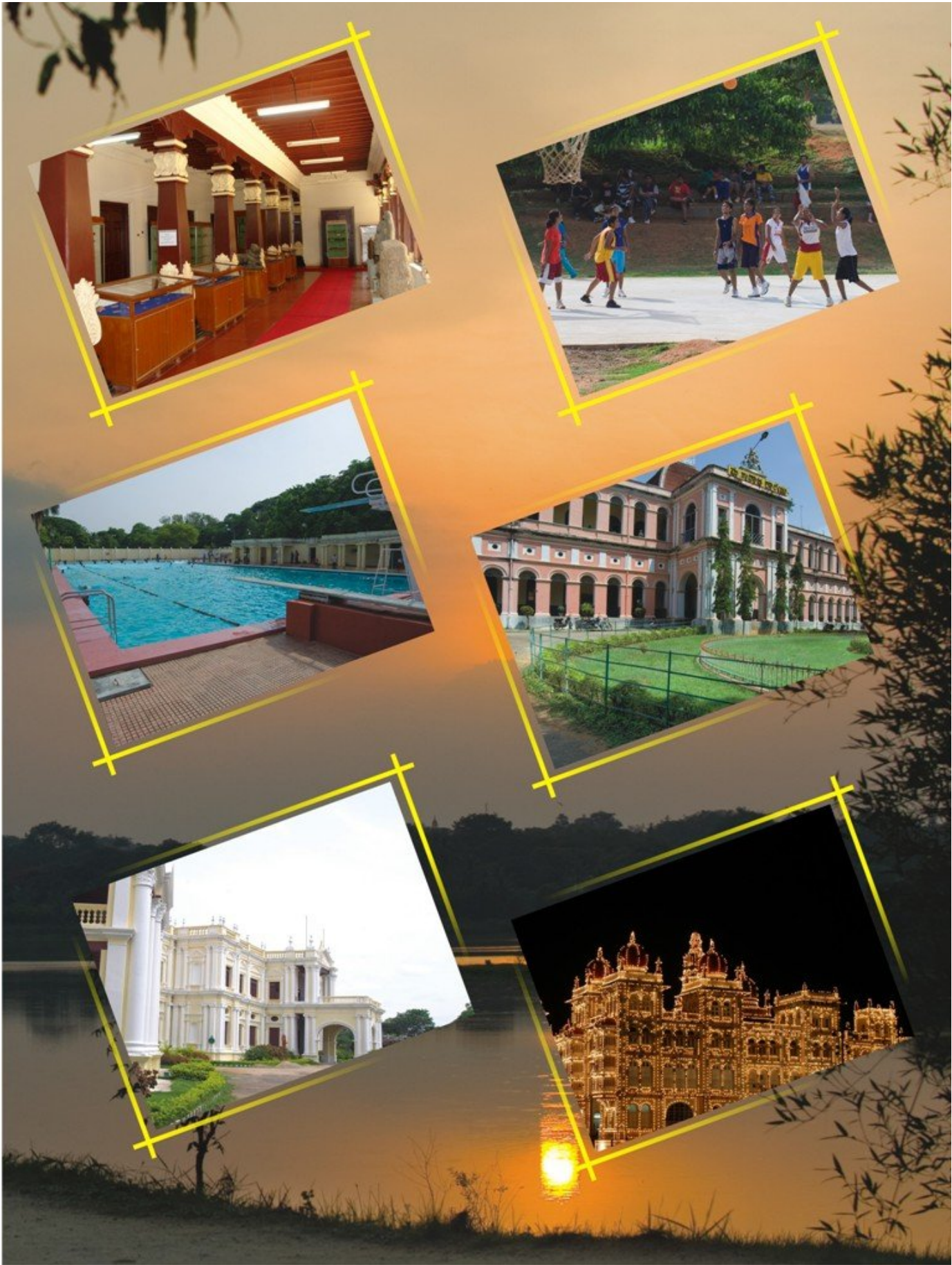
The **International Center** was established by the University of Mysore to promote a global perspective in the teaching, research and outreach programs of the University of Mysore. The Center works in close collaboration with the postgraduate departments and colleges affiliated to the University of Mysore and also other academic and research institutions, which have linkages with the University.

The International Center is committed to providing appropriate support services to international faculty and students in such matters as eligibility assessment, admission, obtaining visa extension and residential permit, placements, establishing linkages with appropriate institutions, finding suitable accommodation for freshers and helping them to connect with fellow citizens and counseling. The Center is also committed to disseminating information on study abroad opportunities and avenues for collaboration to faculty and students of various university departments.

The University of Mysore has introduced a 'Single Window' System to coordinate the admission of international students to various courses offered by the university departments and colleges under the jurisdiction of the University. The Center functions as a liaison between the students, colleges, University, Embassies, the Ministry of Human Resource Development and the Indian Council for Cultural Relations.

The University has put in place a number of systems, which could well be termed our 'Best Practices'. These include:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

International Students seeking admission to different courses in the University of Mysore have to obtain a certificate of eligibility from the University. Eligibility assessment applications can be obtained from the Office of the International Center. The application is also available online in the University and the International Center websites.

The following documents are to be enclosed with an eligibility assessment application:

- Copy of the Passport
- Marks Transcripts of the qualifying examination (if the percentage of marks equivalent to the grade is not shown in the statement of marks, it should be furnished along with a conversion table in English only)
- 2 Passport size photographs
