#### 17. Future Plans.

- 1. The library in the Dept of Studies in History consists of 5,000 Books plus 500 gifted books. It is designed to meet the information needs of students. The library in the department stocked with books, periodicals, National and International Journals in total covering all aspects of academics and research materials. Our library includes National, International, Regional Newspapers which helps our students to know the day to day issues. Library/Reading Hall with Modern technique, Almirahs, Xerox Machine, Fax, telephone, computer with internet facilities will be provided for the students and teachers.
- 2. The department is research oriented for this purpose seminars are essential to improve the personality of the students and research scholars of the department seminars are conducted every week for the benefit of the students. It is necessary to make progress on historical studies and research. Therefore it is necessary to have a big seminar hall with LCD facilities, seminar hall which accommodates 150 students, faculty members and research scholars.
- 3. Modern studies requires the application of computers and internet. To provide these facilities, a computer lab with a minimum of 15 computers along with the accessories, a computer lab will be established for the students, research scholars and faculty.
- 4. There are more than 100 research scholars which includes UGC, ICHR, RGNF, FIP, PDF, SC/ST cell and foreign research scholars. It is necessary to provide them with cubical facilities. So we intend to give them this facility.
- 5. The existing number of students 150+100 research plus 25 M.Phil students, and we are running 4 courses it is necessary to have class rooms and staff rooms which are insufficient, an attempt will be made to improve the classrooms and staff room.
- 6. Department of History came into existence in the year 1894, by 2017 History department is completing 124 years and History department has to sequeetennial celebration, for the whole year of 2017. We will be celebrating sequeetennial of the department by conducting seminars/ conferences/ workshops/ symposium and exhibition.

- 7. We are planning to conduct thematically seminars twice a year in the department and also to publish the research papers presented in the seminars.
- 8. We are planning to build Art Museum and establish centre for collecting and preserving Archival Materials.

- 10. To organize special lectures every month by inviting eminent resource persons to our department.
- 11. Applied History –Inspire programmes for high school and PUC students. Updating historical knowledge to high school and PUC students.
- 12. To conduct heritage awareness for high school, PUC and Degree students.
- 13. Public lectures to popularise the study of History and bring into focus the research work done by the faculty.
- 14. Heritage Exploration by identifying the Monuments, Heritage structures, Irrigational Tanks in Karnataka. Conducting extension activities to educate the people about the importance of preserving the Historical Monuments and prevent their decay or destruction.

For the coming years we want to organize National and International conferences in the Department of History. Seminar on 'Socio-Economic Transformations in 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century India and seminar on the Emerging trends in Historiography of Karnataka.
