GENERAL INFORMATION

- The All India Inter University Kho-Kho women Tournament is scheduled to be held from 05.07.2022 to 07. 07.2022 at Department of Physical Education, Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore, Mysore
- 2. The Distance from Mysore railway station to Department of Physical Education, Sports Pavilion University of Mysore is 2.5k.m. and from Mysore Bus Stand 5k.m.
- Unfurnished accommodation will be provided to teams at Department of Physical Education Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore. Teams should bring their own bedding, locks and keys etc.
- 4. Accommodation will be provided one day prior to their first match and teams should vacate the accommodation within 24hrs after their last match is over.
- A caution deposit of Rs. 1000/- has to be deposited by the team Manager with the organizing secretary and the same will be refunded after adjustment of cost of damages, if any.
- 6. Team Manager's meeting will be held at the department of physical Education Sports Pavilion, University of Mysore on 4th July 2022 at 4p.m. The team Managers are requested to attend this meeting and hand over the eligibility Performa to the organizers.
- 7. Team Managers should bring one copy of the Eligibility Performa of the players duly typed and signed by their Registrar/Director of Physical Education/Sports officer of the Participating University along with the player's identity cards and all the students should produce photo copy of +2 examination, Date of Birth certificate and in case of PG students, the pass certificate of the Degree course, duly attested by Director of Physical Education/ Secretary Sports Board/ Council/Sports officer/Registrar of the concerned university along with their eligibility certificate and a copy of subscription receipt obtained from AIU, New Delhi should be handed over to the organizing secretary at the time of registration.
- The Inaugural function will be at 8.00 am on 05-07-2022. All the Participating teams are requested to bring flag of their university; flags are essential and compulsory for march past.
- 9. Matches will be conducted in accordance with the latest rules of Kho-Kho Federation of India. as adopted by AIU, New Delhi.
- 10. The Matches will be played on Gravel Ground and if situation Warrants Matches will be held on Synthetic Surface (indoors) under flood lights. Therefore the players should be advised to equip them selves with shoe suitable for play on Synthetic Surface(Mat)
- 11. The climate in Mysore during July is quite pleasant.

- 12. First aid facilities and immediate medical assistance will be provided by the organizers to attend the injured.
- 13. Officiating charges of Rs. 1,500/- per team per match as per AIU guidelines will have to be paid by the participating University to the organizing secretary.
- 14. Decision of the Tournament committee on all matters relating to the Tournament shall be final and binding on teams.
- 15. Organizing secretary reserves the right to make changes of the venue, date and time of the matches.
- 16. Participating Universities are requested to inform their arrival, date, time train name and train number to the organizing secretary well in advance to make necessary arrangements.
- 17. Teams should report at least 30 minutes before the commencement of their match.
- 18. Morning session matches start at. 8.00am. and evening session matches start at 2.00pm.
