The Project ends on 30.06.2018 and the selected Project Fellow shall work in the Project till 30.06.2018.

Project Fellow gets a consolidated fellowship of: i) **NET/GATE qualified-**Rs. 16,000/- p.m. for initial 2 years and Rs. 18,000/- p.m. for the third year. ii) **Non-GATE/Non-NET-** Rs. 14,000/- p.m. for initial 2 years and Rs. 16,000/- p.m. for the third year.

The person to be considered for appointment as Project Fellow must have second class M.Sc. degree in Statistics with a minimum of 55% marks for general category (50% in case of SC/ST) or M.Phil. in Statistics. The candidate to be appointed as Project Fellow should be below the age of 40 years on the date of appointment. The Project Fellow should do work full time in the project and get the fellowship from one source only.
