## **BACKGROUND OF THE WORKSHOP**

The issues relating to human rights which are necessary to be stressed upon on the target group relate to both civil and political rights as well as the social, economic and cultural rights. The Commission is concerned about the prevailing criminal justice system and the reforms needed in the area of police functioning so that the civil and political rights of people are better protected. The system should provide for sufficient remedies against their violation. The issues of importance in this area are rights of the prisoners, especially those under trial, custodial justice and prevention of custodial violence, fake encounters, pendency of cases in courts etc At the same time, the Commission is also concerned about the need for ensuring the basic needs of people so that they are not deprived of basic necessities like food, health, housing, sanitation and clean drinking water as well as a clean environment to ensure their proper development and quality of life.(NHRC web)
