### **University of Mysore**

The University of Mysore was established on July 27, 1916. It is the sixth oldest in the country and the first in the state of Karnataka. Also, in a sense it is the first university of the country to be established outside the limits of the British India. The university was founded as a result of the efforts of the benevolent and visionary Maharaja of erstwhile Princely State of Mysore His Highness Shri Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wadiyar – IV (1884-1940), and the then Dewan Sir M. Vishvesvaraya (1860-1962). It was the first University to be accredited by NAAC in 2000 with Five Star Status. The university is now ranked 36th in the India Rankings 2017, NIRF-MHRD, Government of India.

### **Indian Dietetic Association**

In 1962, a group of like-minded nutritionists, dietitians and workers in the allied health fields resolved to form a scientific body to highlight the importance of dietetics and nutrition in the maintenance of health, and in the prevention and treatment of diseases. Thus, the Indian Dietetic Association was founded, with Prof. Kalyan Bagchi as Secretary and Dr. C. Gopalan as President. The association was affiliated to the International Congress of Dietetics in 1975. The Headquarters of IDA is located in Kolkata. The main objective of the association is to promote the cause of science by encouraging the spirit of active pursuit of knowledge and original scientific research particularly in the field of Nutrition and Dietetics. Currently there are 23 chapters with more than 13,000 life members pan India.

### **Department of Studies in Food Science and Nutrition**

The department is offering Postgraduate and Doctoral Program in Food Science and Nutrition since 1970 and in Human Development since 1993. The department has well equipped and furnished classrooms, staff rooms, research laboratories. It has to its credit 900 dissertations, 75 Ph.D. degrees, 700 publications in peer-reviewed journals, more than 850 scientific papers presented in various National/International seminars, conferences, workshops, 32 research projects completed and 2 on-going projects. The faculty members provide consultancy services at Counseling centers, Clinics, Food industry, Hospitals and other organizations on invitation. Faculty has won various awards for their research contribution.

The research activities have received financial assistance from CSIR, DST, UGC, UNICEF and DRDO. The areas of Clinical research include diabetes, hyperlipidemia and renal disease. Other areas of research include community nutrition, public health, product development, food processing and storage. The department has received funds from UGC under Special Assistance Program since 2007, and upgraded to DRS II level w.e.f 2013. The major thrust area being, (1) Development of disease specific functional foods, (2) Clinical trials in target groups, (3) Nutritional assessment and education in school children.

### **Major thrust area of the Symposium**

The field of Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics has witnessed considerable growth over the past decade, largely attributed to the increasing awareness among healthcare professionals and general public. The interface between nutrition and medicine in health care is dynamic, complex and inter related. The foundation of clinical nutrition is grounded in basic nutrition research. The past decade has seen remarkable scientific and technological advances in nutrition research with an impact on the methods of nutritional support. The symposium provides an opportunity to explore the current practices and future trends in the field by eminent speakers.
