Essential Qualifications: Project Fellow:

- First class Masters Degree in any one of the following subjects: Mass Communication and Journalism, Political Science, Economics, Development Studies, Sociology and Social work.
- The selected research scholars must have the ability to work in the areas of interdisciplinary research. The research basically consists of collection of data and analysis in interdisciplinary areas of social sciences.
