1. ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The National Workshop on Multidisciplinary Research is a unique attempt to mainstream research across disciplines that intertwines the spirit of different disciplines in the pursuit of finding solutions to varied human problems. This three-day workshop is designed to facilitate bringing together researchers from different parts of India, to deliberate, share experiences and carve out the ways of bringing multidisciplinary research to fore in the centres of higher learning.

1.1 MULTIDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH : Multidisciplinary research is a pursuit of truth with the help of numerous specialized branches of learning which aims at achieving a common aim with the aid of knowledge of other disciplines. Multidisciplinary research is an investigation or inquiry to a problem for ascertaining the hypothesis combining many academic approaches, fields or methods. Further, it can be defined as a search for knowledge through objective and systemic method for an original contribution to the existing stock of knowledge involving a combination of several disciplines and methods.

Multidisciplinary approach is very much in vogue in developing countries to approach and analyze the contemporary problems. It represents a progressive scholarly method. Multidisciplinary approach means that knowledge of several disciplines are used to a given problem and are supplementary to one another in such a way that it is possible to draw clear cut conclusion, free from being branded as isolated or partial one. In multidisciplinary research a number of fields are involved in a certain line of inquiry which is specific to a problem or region. But the individual findings of the disciplines involved are only brought together in a cumulative fashion. Therefore, modern research is tending to be more and more multidisciplinary.

1.2: WORKSHOP METHODOLOGY: The workshop will feature plenary sessions with Key Presentations by renowned researchers on all days. Each Key Presentation will be followed by Panel Discussions that range from issues of research methodology, strategies for making multidisciplinary research a focal area in university research endeavors, showcasing multidisciplinary research in pure sciences, applied sciences, social sciences, management sciences etc. Each session of 90 minutes will be divided into two equal parts, with one part involving discussions by panelists and the other deliberations by the participants. The workshop will also feature Poster Sessions, where the participants can display the posters related to multidisciplinary research.

2. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The workshop will be of interest and use to all those who are interested in understanding the key issues of multidisciplinary research. Research Scholars pursuing doctoral studies, Post Graduate Students, people working in Civil Society Organizations such as NGOs, Policy Makers, and Corporate Executives will all have something to gain from this workshop. The workshop is open to all those who wish to learn through participatory mode about multidisciplinary research. A maximum of 100 participants will be accepted on first-come-first-serve basis.

3. WORKSHOP REGISTRATION:

The workshop will feature presentations by experts in different fields who would either give a key presentation or participate as panelists. The participants will have ample opportunity both to interact with these experts as well as to participate in deliberations. By end of this workshop, it is hoped that the participants will get adequate exposure to the nuances of multidisciplinary research. Those registering to the workshop are advised to take note of the following:

3.1 REGISTRATION FEE: Each institution can send a maximum of two participants by paying a registration fee of INR 10,000. The fee may be paid through Demand Draft in favour of The Director, IDS, University of Mysore. Registered participants will be provided a workshop kit, lunch and mid-session tea during the period of workshop.
